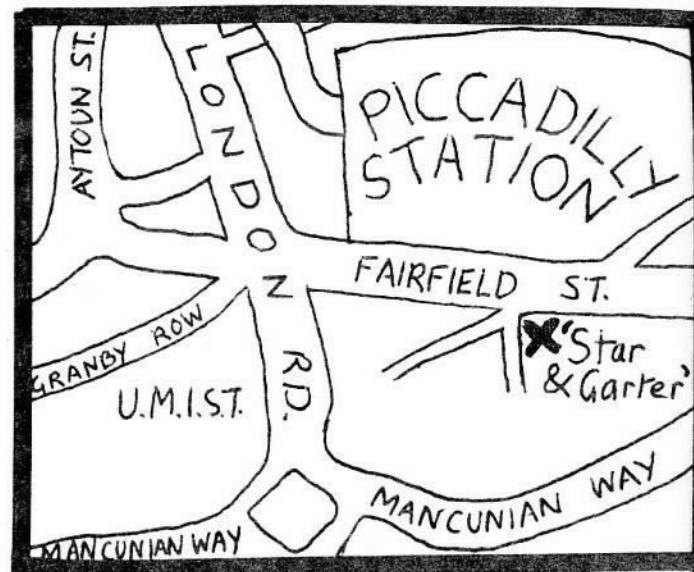
The march against the Nationality Bill is an important part of the struggle against Racism and Fascism, but still only a part.
