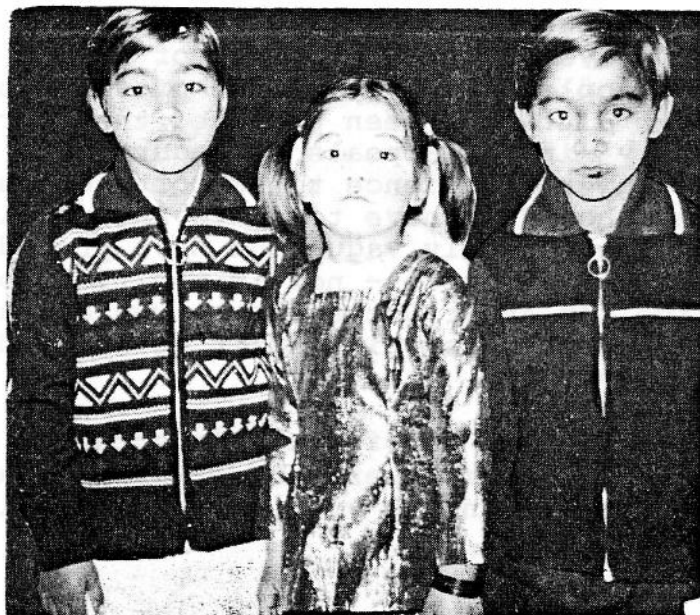

JOIN THE GROWING CAMPAIGN

The campaign to reunite Anwar Ditta's family and win a victory against the racism of the Home Office is gathering force. The campaign recently held 3 pickets; of the Home Office in London of Rochdale Tory Party Office and of Timothy Raison (Home Office Minister for Immigration) on his recent visit to Manchester.

The Rochdale picket was supported by both the Bradford and Leicester Asian Youth Movements. The picket of Raison was supported by over 60 people. Because of the pressure of the campaign to date Anwar Ditta has been promised that her case is receiving 'top priority' in the appeals procedure both in London and Manchester. But Anwar's evidence to support her case is so overwhelming that she shouldn't have to go to an appeal. Also Home Office promises are not only vague but have proved useless in the past. The answer is simple:- now is the time to step up the campaign! Justice for Anwar Ditta can be won and a blow struck against the immigration controls which split up hundreds of families in the same way.

The Demonstration of March 1st is of vital importance, already support has been promised from Liverpool, Bradford, Manchester and other areas. Be there! Ensure your organisation is represented!
