Dear Sir/~~Madam~~,

I enclose a copy of an Emergency Certificate which has been granted to you. The original Certificate has been sent to your Solicitor.

The Emergency Certificate has been issued to enable your Solicitor to take immediate steps on your behalf, before an assessment of your means has been carried out by the Legal Aid Assessment Office.

It is, therefore, extremely important that if you are contacted by that office you co-operate fully and immediately.

It sometimes happens that for some reason a case does not proceed after an Emergency Certificate has been issued, but in these circumstances if work has been done by your Solicitor it is still necessary for an assessment to be carried out.

Failure to co-operate may lead to your Emergency Certificate being discharged or revoked and in the latter case you would be personally liable for all the costs incurred under it.

On the other hand, your full co-operation will lead, in due course, to the issue of a full replacement Certificate under which you will only be called upon to pay such contribution (if any) as is consistent with your financial position as assessed under the Regulations.
