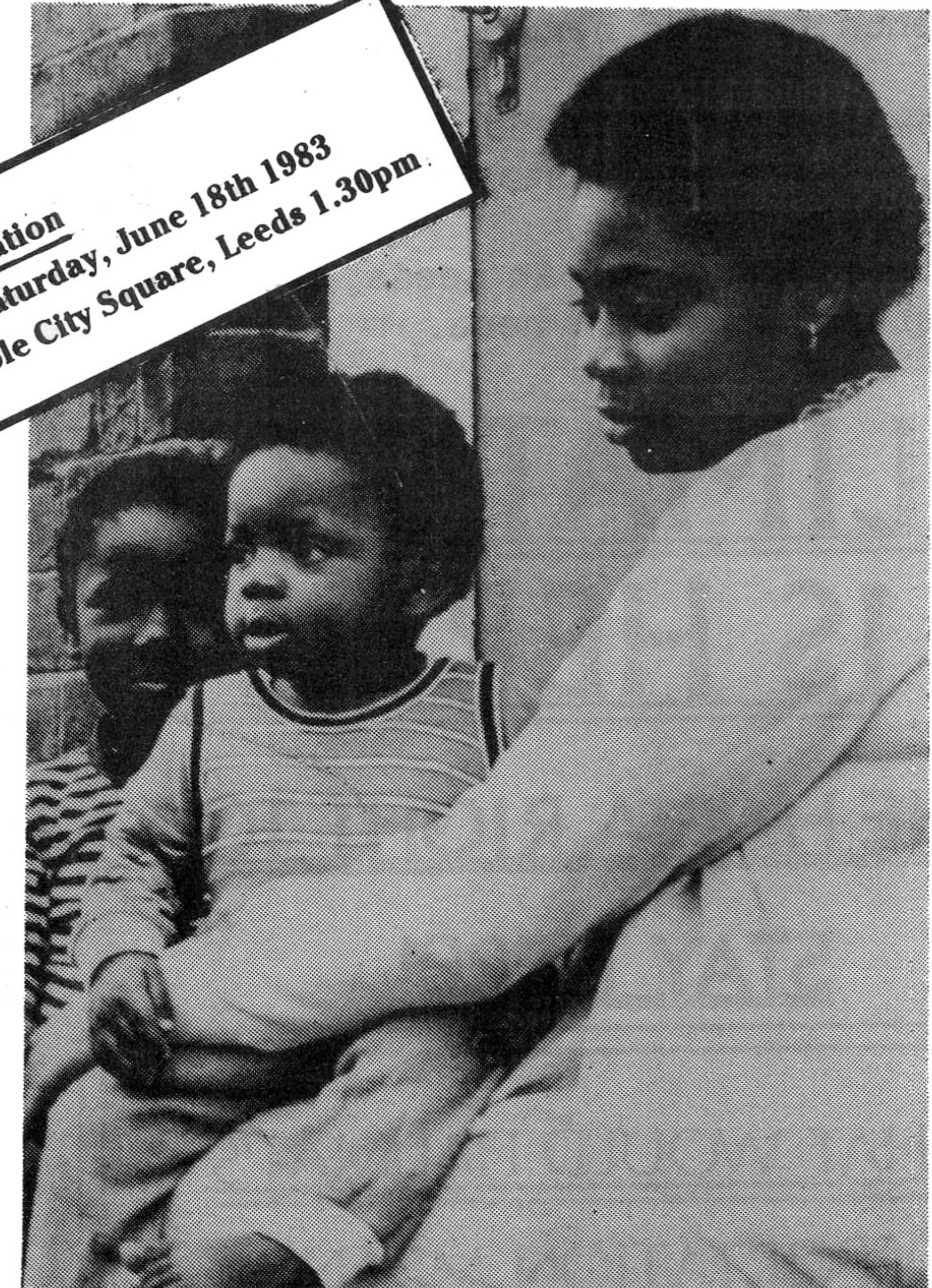

"If I go back to Nigeria, my children will be taken from me. I will face the same violence from my husband. I will not be able to work. I have no family to go to. I have no home in Nigeria. I believe my home and my children's home is in this country."

## LEGAL EXPERT CONFIRMS

### HALIMAT'S FEARS.

A leading expert in Nigerian law, Dr. David Pearl of Fitzwilliam College, Camb., says:

- Halimat's husband "WOULD HAVE LITTLE DIFFICULTY IN OBTAINING CUSTODY."
- He adds: ".....THE HUSBAND HAS THE RIGHT TO CONTROL THE WIFE'S ACTIVITIES, SUCH AS WHETHER SHE WORKS AND SO ON....."
