

Model Resolution for Union Branches and other organisations

This Branch of (union) notes the case of Halimat Babamba, and her two children Hakeem and Mustapha, who face deportation under the racist and sexist immigration laws unless her appeal to be allowed to remain in Britain on compassionate grounds is granted by the Home Office.

It therefore resolves to:

- i. write to David Waddington at the Home Office, 50 Queen Anne's Gate, London SW1 (quoting ref. no. B361976) asking him to allow Halimat and her children permanent residence in Britain.
- ii. write to Halimat's MP, Stan Cohen, in support of his efforts on her behalf and encouraging him to keep up pressure on the Home Office.
- iii. affiliate to the campaign 'Friends of Halimat Babamba' with an affiliation fee of £ , also enclosing a copy of the motion passed.
- iv. publicise Halimat's plight and circulate other branches of this union and National Office with copies of this motion.
- v. invite Halimat or speaker from the campaign to meetings and collect signatures for the petition and hold a collection at branch meetings.
- vi. support campaign activities.
