Aurang Zeb Aged 13 Years

AURANG ZEB was 13 years old when he was sent here by his parents from Pakistan under the name of Mohammed Rafiq in 1972. At that age Aurang Zeb cannot be held responsible for his parents deception and was not in a position to contradict his parents.

AZMAT PARVEEN, his wife, knew nothing of his illegal status until after she had entered this country and married him.

THE COUPLE had their first child in May 1979, SHERAZ AHMED, in September 1982 their second child was born, FARKHANDA JABEEN. Both children are BRITISH CITIZENS.

NOW, ten years later, the Home Office is threatening to deport AURANG ZEB and the rest of his family.

AURANG ZEB entered before 1st January 1973 (when the 1971 Immigration Act came into effect) and the Act should not be applied retrospectively. Aurang Zeb should qualify for Amnesty, the Home Office have disqualified him from this because he made a short visit to Pakistan in 1976.

AZMAT PARVEEN is threatened with deportation because of her husbands illegal status, which is no fault of hers. Their two children, both BRITISH CITIZENS; face deportation because of their father's illegal status.

AURANG ZEB has lived here for ten years. All his adult life. He was educated here, has married here and his two children were born here.

AURANG ZEB'S parents have ordered him to leave his wife, he refused and has been disowned. He has no where to live in Pakistan and no job prospects. His family will not help him and Azmat Parveen's cannot help.
