You are cordially invited to this conference. Invitation to this conference was agreed to be at the discretion of individuals/groups present at the Black Caucus meetings.


To finance the conference (venue and food) it was decided to charge all waged people attending the conference a sum of £2.00. The conference is free to unwaged people. The venue of the conference is at:
