

STOP RANJITS DEPORTATION

MARCH AGAINST RACISM

On Saturday 12th February the Asian Youth Movement is organising an anti-racist march from Burngreave to the City Hall, under the slogan's 'stop racial and police harassment' and 'stop Ranjit's deportation'. The Sheffield Campaign Against Racism is supporting this protest. Why?

Because Ranjit Chakravorty is threatened with deportation in spite of the fact that, since he arrived in Sheffield in 1977, he had made a valuable contribution to the community which has been recognised by numerous bodies, including the City Council.

Because Britains new Nationality Act discriminates against black people and has created a situation where people legally settled here for many years will have to pay £200 for each member of their family who needs to register as a British citizen.

Because the Government is introducing a Police Bill which gives the police increased powers to stop and search people in the streets, to detain people without charging them and enter premises to look for evidence against a suspect - without any real come back if these powers are unjustly used against innocent people.

Because there is already considerable concern about the way in which the police abuse their existing powers by, for example, not notifying parents or community workers immediately when juveniles have been arrested.

For these reasons, we urge you to demonstrate your unity against racism and your determination to defend everyone's civil liberties by supporting the march.
