3 YEAR OLD TO BE DEPORTED STOP THIS LAW NOW

LIM KOK KEONG, a 3 year old Malaysian boy, has been refused entry to this Country by the British Immigration authorities. Keong's mother is in Australia receiving medical treatment for cancer. His father is forced to work in Singapore to earn money to pay for her treatment. His only relatives in Malaysia are old, infirm 70 year old grandparents. On the 17th May Keong arrived in the U.K. with his aunt and uncle, Mr and Mrs Lim who were bringing him home with them to Britain for 6 months to look after him until his parents can take him back to Malaysia. On arrival at Heathrow Keong was refused admission because the Immigration Officer was not satisfied that he would only stay for 6 months, despite assurances given by Mr and Mrs Lim. Keong is supposed to travel back to Malaysia, alone, on 26th May, with no-one to care for him when he arrives there.

Not only is the refusal decision inhumane and unsympathetic, but the Immigration Officer who made it, did so in a completely unreasonable manner. After a 17 hour flight Mr Lim was interviewed without an interpreter and without being offered a rest, food, or drink for 3 hours. Mrs Lim was denied an interview. They were refused access to the Chief Immigration Officer, and were advised that it was a "waste of time", exercising their right of appeal.

The family are determined to fight the Immigration Officers' ruling, and to get the Home Secretary to overturn the decision. Representations are being made now through the family's M.P. Fred Mulley.

We need the support of people in Sheffield to fight against the racist Immigration Laws shown at their most inhumane in this case. Would this have happened to a white child?
