## Free the Bradford 12

The Bradford Twelve still need your support. They are going on trial in Leeds on April 26th, the charges being conspiracy to make explosives, damage property and cause grievous bodily harm. The evidence for these charges are a crate of petrol bombs which none of the Twelve were ever seen near, and the 'voluntary statements' made during thirty hours of isolation and interrogation immediately prior to being charged. After this the Twelve were held for three months before being granted bail under very heavy constraints.

The defendants may face life-sentences as a result of these charges; their treatment contrasts greatly with that of white racists who have burnt Asian shops and homes. This differential treatment can be seen as the police response to the Bradford Twelve's concern with combatting racism, - they are all members or supporters of the United Black Youth League, - and also as part of the general repression of working class people organising to protect themselves and their living standards.

The speakers will include Anwar Ditta who has faced state racism in her long struggle for her children to be allowed into Britain. Please show your continued support by coming along to the meeting. Time is running out.
