We want to bring to your attention the strike by 21 Asian Workers at Aire Valley Yarns Ltd. in Farley near Bradford. They have been made redundant because of forming a union (TGW) to organise for better pay and conditions (further details are enclosed within).

In the light of this the Asian Youth Movement is organising a Public Meeting on Sunday 12th June to mobilise support for the strikers. Members of the strike committee will be present to enlighten us on any new developments taking place. We urge your organisation to be present at the meeting to partake in the discussion so that support can be mobilised both locally and nationally.

It is important to see the strike as an example to us all as they fight for their rights under this growing climate of massive unemployment and recession.
