SUPPORT MANJIT KAUR PICKET DAVID WADDINGTON (HOME OFFICE)

250 people a month are deported from Britain, many are held for months in detention centres.

At the Tory Conference last October a motion from Harvey Proctor MP, a N F supporter called for voluntary repatriation - this resolution was defeated. David Waddington spoke in this debate, saying that black people were welcome! This was but a thin veneer of the overt racism of the Tory Party. The black Community is criminalised by the racist nationality Act - only those whose grandfather or father was born here and their dependents are allowed into Britain i.e. white people from Canada, Australia and South Africa. IN OTHER WORDS * IF YOU ARE BLACK YOU ARE NOT WELCOME!

Once this is established all black citizens are targets for suspicion - suspicion of being "illegal" immigrants. The Police and Immigration Officials use this excuse to harass the black community. Homes of suspected overstayers are raided late at night. Individuals are forcibly removed and kept in detention centres until deported. Rarely do these cases come to light - people are frightened to fight for their right to stay.

The Sheffield Defence Campaign have fought several local cases successfully. In Manchester Manjit Kaur is presently fighting for the right to stay. In Birmingham social worker Mohammed Idrish has won the backing of his union NALGO.

David Waddington, Home Office Minister in charge of Immigration is speaking in Sheffield on Friday 9th March. He is here to gain support and credibility in the black community. DON'T LET HIM GET AWAY WITH IT.....PICKET THE MEETING ALONGSIDE THE MANJIT KAUR DEFENSE CAMPAIGN.
