In the incident in which Ahmed Khan was arrested:

- 15 white youths attacked the Shizar Restaurant
- Customers and staff were injured
- The Police, though repeatedly called, took 20 minutes to arrive.
- When they did come, they arrested one of the victims!

On August 14 hundreds marched through Sheffield to protest against the arrest and prosecution of Ahmed Khan. This is in itself an injustice, but the reason so many turned out to march in protest and have come to pickets and meetings, and why many more in the community are angry, is because this is not just one case. It is but one of many attacks on black people in Sheffield, and only one of many times the police have behaved in a racist way when dealing with black people's complaints.

POLICE INDIFFERENCE AND HARRASSMENT

Places of worship, isolated families, taxi drivers, restaurants, all have been frequently attacked in Sheffield, including attacks with fire. Repeatedly the Police take little or no action or, as with Ahmed Khan, actually penalise the black victim.
