PETITION

We, the undersigned, note with anger and concern the murder of 16 years old Eustace Pryce in Newham in November 1984 by white racist thugs and the subsequent treatment of his family. We also note the arrest of his brother Gerald along with four other black youths, two Asians and two Afro-Caribbeans, for defending themselves and their community from racist attacks. We demand that the charge of affray against the five be dropped. We also condemn the repressive and inhuman bail conditions imposed on Gerald which prevent him from coming in to Newham while the murderer walks freely around the area. We believe that this represents yet again the failure of the police to protect the black community from racist attacks and instead attempt to criminalise black youth. We demand justice for the Pryce family, who on the one hand have lost one son and on the other hand are prevented from meeting another son in their time of grief.
