The safest route out of the area by public transport is via East Ham tube on the District Line.

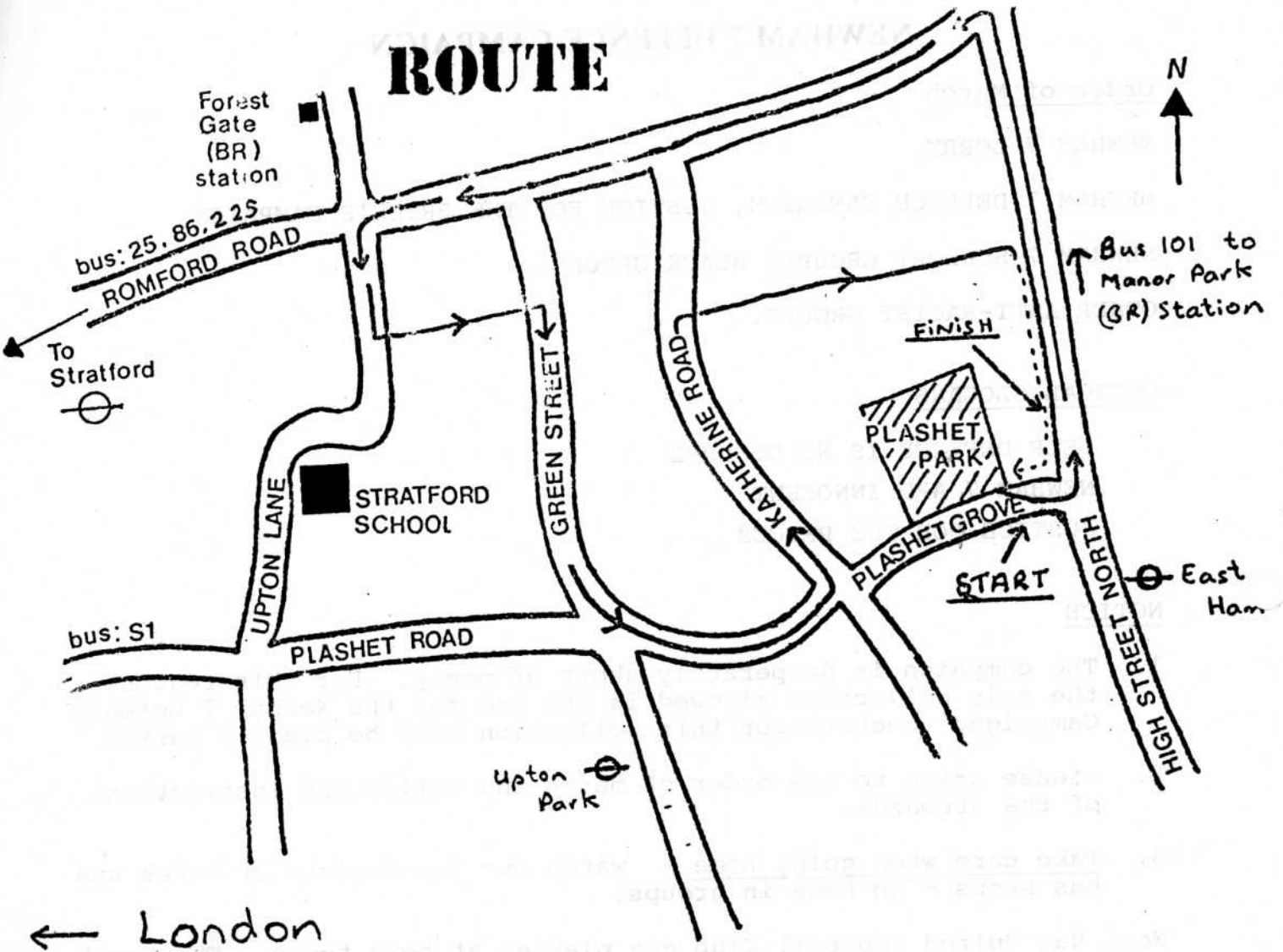
NEWHAM 7 DEFENCE CAMPAIGN

The trial of the 7 starts at the Old Bailey on MONDAY, 13th MAY. A national mass picket has been called of the Old Bailey on the day starting at 9.30 a.m. It is important to have a large turnout on the day in support of the seven youths.

Mass pickets of the Old Bailey will be held every Monday during the course of the trial and support is requested for all the pickets. In addition, it is essential that supporters get petitions signed before the case commences; write to the police, Home Secretary, and the trial judge at the Old Bailey drawing attention to the circumstances surrounding the arrest of the 7 and the strong feeling in the community against the arrests. Also get your organisation to affiliate to the Defence Campaign. Model resolutions, petitions, stickers, posters and leaflets can be obtained by writing to the campaign at P.O. Box 273, London E.7.

YOUR RIGHTS ON ARREST

If you are arrested:

DO

DO NOT

- **DO** shout your name and address to the person nearest to you and ask them to notify Newham Rights Centre (555 3331). Repeat the request at the police station as you have the right to have someone informed.
- **DO** ask why you have been arrested as you are entitled to know.
- **DO** note the number of the police officers involved in your arrest.
- **DO** give your name and address to the police otherwise you may not get bail.
- **DO** ask for a solicitor.
- ★ **DO NOT** resist arrest.
- ★ **DO NOT** make a written statement or sign anything except a list of your possessions.
- ★ **DO NOT** plead guilty to anything.
