Fascism and racism didn't stop claiming victims in 1945. Throughout Europe racism and organised fascism is again on the march. In Britain in the last ten years Black people have been the victims of racist murders, and countless others have been the victims of firebombings, assault, harassment and discrimination. The wave of racism and fascism is growing fast. It must be stopped in its tracks.

Every year the Nazis of the National Front and BNP parade to the Cenotaph on Remembrance Sunday, trying to gain a veneer of respectability and 'patriotism' for their fascist and pro-Nazi views. This regular Nazi stunt is an insult to the thousands of British and Commonwealth servicepeople who gave their lives in the war against Nazism, and to the millions of soldiers and civilians in all other countries who were also killed by the Nazis, whose poisonous creed the British fascist groups still espouse today.

AFA is calling upon all anti-fascists and anti-racists to march on Sunday Nov. 9th in commemoration of ALL the victims of fascism and racism, both in the period up to 1945, and even more importantly, the victims today. In contrast to the jingoism of much of the official Remembrance Day events AFA is stressing that the only way to honour the victims of fascism in the past is to organise to defeat it again today, in Britain.

ASSEMBLE IN TRAFALGAR SQUARE AT 1pm.
The march will pass the Cenotaph later in the day.
