In a meeting of Black Organisations held on 12th May 1985, at the Pakistan Community Centre, the following was resolved.

- (i) To establish an Action Committee Against Racism to combat Racism in whatever form it exists in the City.
- (ii) To mobilise public protest against the Bradford Councils conduct re: Honeyford Affair, and
- (iii) A Sub-Committee was set up to Facilitate (ii).

The Sub-Committee has been meeting with a view to mobilising a mass Public Demonstration on 21st JUNE 1985. So far the following concrete steps have been taken:

- (i) A leaflet to publicize the event on 21st JUNE 1985 has been designed and is in the process of being printed in various languages.
- (ii) Posters to publicise the demonstration are being designed and will shortly be printed.
