# Apartheid in South Africa

Under apartheid the role of black people is to provide a pool of cheap labour. The women, old people, children and the sick are dumped in the bantustans living in extreme poverty.

Over 20 million 'blacks' have no vote and no citizenship in their own country.

During 1984 3,415 children were imprisoned with their mothers under the pass laws.

Any protest is met with brutal oppression: murder, thousands arrested and detention without trial.

Under detention the detainees are deprived of sleep, food and drinks, communication with friends, relatives and other prisoners. Under the state of emergency laws, prisoners can be kept imprisoned indefinitely.

## Apartheid in Britain

The South African people are calling for complete economic, political and cultural isolation of the apartheid regime. British companies actually break this boycott and therefore are helping to finance apartheid. This money poured into South Africa finances military spending, the illegal occupation of Namibia, sanctions busting, and the internal terror apparatus. Britain today is still South Africa's main economic and political backer.

Britain also has institutionalised racism, including discriminatory immigration laws. This was highlighted in the recent case against the British government by the European Court of Human Rights.

Effective campaigning in Britain can build a movement to stop British investment in South Africa and destroy apartheid.

Despite death squads, police terror, detention, show trials and torture the youth, the workers and the people of South Africa are continuing to show the world they demand their freedom. And they demand it NOW.
