Dear Friend(s),

I am writing to inform you of a deportation case involving a woman from Ghana. She came to England as a student to do a secretarial course for two years and **as far as** she was concerned she came here on a student visa. Her passport was taken from her by her uncle for safe-keeping on arrival in England. During her stay in England she has not had her passport in her possession at any given time.

I enclose a copy of the letter which I sent to local councillors and the Dir. of Social Services, it gives more details of the case.

The Home Office had actually booked a flight for her deportation from the U.K. for the 20th. August 1984. Sue Shutter from J.C.W.I. has made representations to her M.P. who has written to David Waddington and the deportations have been stayed until a reply has been received from D. Waddington.

Much hard work is required in order for this campaign to be successful and for subsequent similar campaigns to stand any chance of success. I hope that you can support this campaign and issue as indeed it is a national one which divides families and causes the people concerned great distress and fear.
