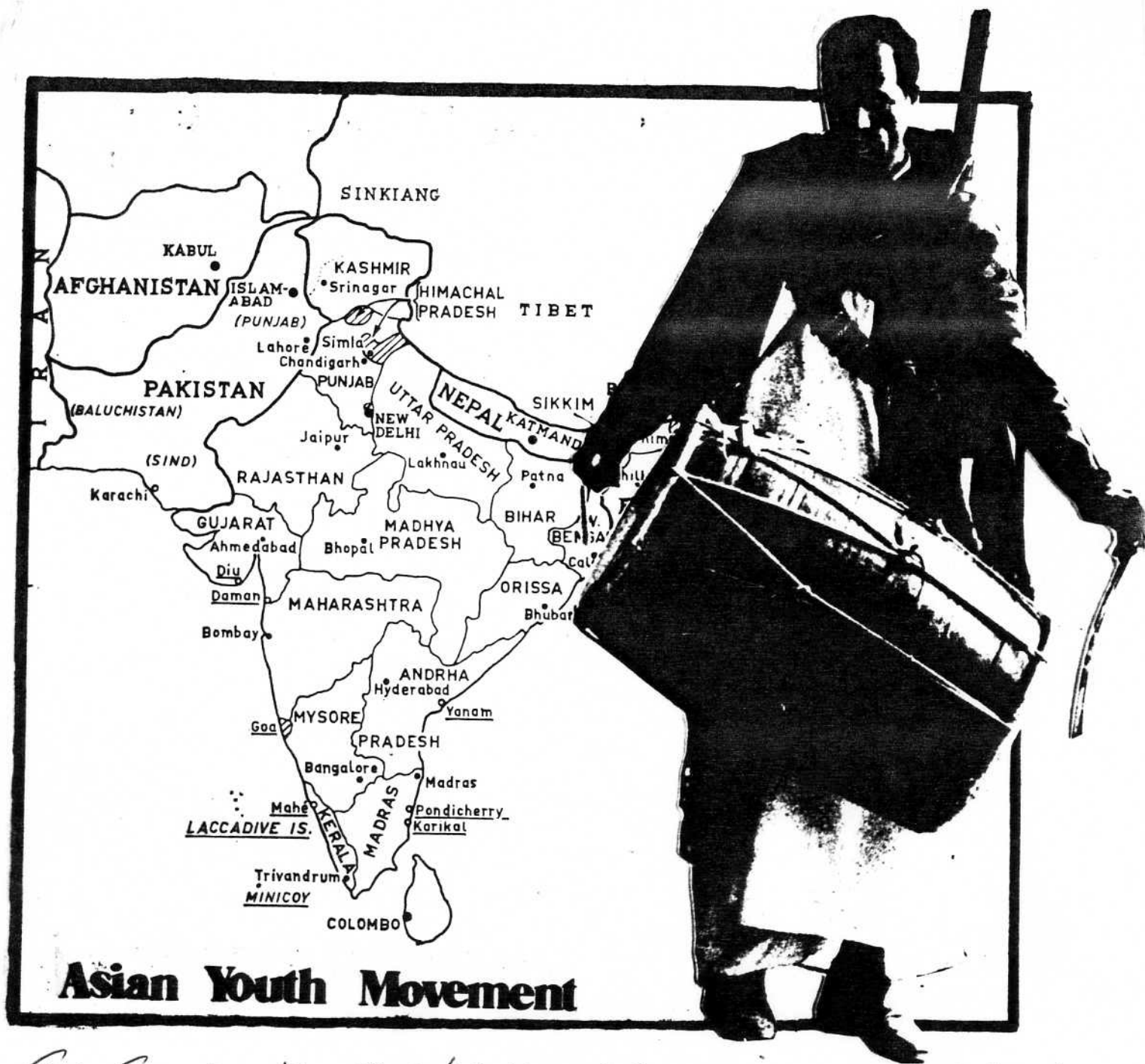




This Then is the First 'National Campaigns Circulation' Package. It contains leaflets / information mailed to us during August 84.

Dear Sisters / Brothers

On the 5th August 1984, after the Karamjit Singh Demonstration in Birmingham, activists from Newham Sheffield, Coventry, Birmingham, Greenwich and Hackney held a meeting at which invaluable information on local campaigns was exchanged.

During the course of the meeting it became clear that a permanent structure needs to evolve where by the various Black groups through-out the country can be kept informed of the local campaigns.

The meeting went on to select Sheffield as a central point to which leaflets / information needing national circulation would be sent.

It's our responsibility, in Sheffield to collate through the month, leaflets / information and at the end of each month to mail-out the material to groups who are on the contact list.

It is hoped that the 'National Campaigns Circulation' would result in closer links between existing Black groups and give national focus to local campaigns.

* A national meeting as been organised after the Newham 7 picket on Sept 14th in London. There will be a review of the 'National Campaigns circulation' and other important issues will be on the agenda. All Black activists are invited to stay behind after the picket and partake in the discussion.
