12 anti-fascists were arrested on Saturday 13th April 1985 whilst demonstrating against the fascist British National Party. The BNP were given permission by the Council to hold a public election meeting at Hutton Middle School. It wasn't a public meeting but a Fascist rally. Bradford's anti-fascist Community protested at the presence of Führer Tyndall and his fascist rabble in a Bradford School. The Fascists attacked the protestors. The police arrested 12 anti-fascists. Surprise! Surprise! These 12 anti-fascists were up before the Courts on 9th September 1985. Three of the defendants were acquitted. The other nine received bind overs of upto £1,000, for a period of two years. As a result of this the defendants have decided to appeal against the Courts decision. The bindovers are political and are used to suppress activity against fascism within our Community. The appeal Court hearing is on:
