

THE BELLE VUE ATTACK

At approx 2.15am on 6th October '85 a coach load of whites from outside Bradford descended near a cafe in Manningham Lane. A brick was thrown, smashing the cafe window. Three women sitting by the window were badly cut by shattered glass. The police who were around, let all this happen unhindered while preventing a gathering crowd of mainly black Bradfordians from getting near the scene. There were some missiles aimed towards the coach from the back of the angry and agitated crowd. The police set dogs on them and arrested two by-standers. They called for reinforcements and prepared for a riot situation. They escorted the coach with the racists out of Bradford. They did not arrest any of the real offenders.

A campaign has been formed by the people who were at the scene, including the two defendants. Defendants have been charged with causing criminal damage to the coach.
