

BLACK COMMUNITY UNDER ATTACK

On Saturday 25th May, 3 more Asians were the target of racist attack in the Bowling area of Bradford.

Gurmail Singh, Amarjit Singh and Dara Singh were brutally attacked outside the Gallopers public bar on Wakefield Road, by a group of 8 white racists. Gurmail Singh was attacked with bottles and broken glass. He received several stitches and plastic surgery on his eye. Amarjit Singh was badly beaten up and received several stitches in his head. His face and body were bruised. Dara Singh received bruises to his body and his chest. Both Gurmail and Amarjit were beaten up so badly that they were left unconscious.

Not surprisingly, the police have not arrested the attackers. The local media has treated this as a gang fight.

This is not an isolated incident, it is part of a series of attacks that the black community is witnessing in Bradford.

These attacks will continue unless the black community organises itself independently. The Bowling Asian Action Group has called a public meeting on racist attacks and we are calling on all black people and anti-racists to attend - to condemn these attacks and organise against them.
