

GARY PEMBERTON NEEDS YOUR SUPPORT!

As you should now be aware Gary Pemberton, a West Indian (who works as a Security Officer for Bradford College Students' Union) was arrested on the 15th October 1980 and charged with 'assault on a police officer'. This is a serious charge and the case is to be heard on Tuesday, 27th January, 1981 in Bradford.

The Students' Union feel that it is essential to see that Gary's legal defence is of the best possible standard, but Gary is most anxious to have a powerful political campaign to accompany this. Make no mistake about it Gary is absolutely innocent of the charge and it seems likely that the police's attack on Gary is racist and should be treated as such in a political campaign.

It has been decided that the Students' Union will organise a mass picket of the court on the 27th January at 10 a.m., but that exact details of this will be discussed by a public meeting at Queens Hall on Monday, 26th January at 7.30 p.m. The Executive wish to make a strong plea for your attendance at both this meeting and the picket, so as to show our total opposition to these attacks on black people by the police.

At the moment the Executive are also working with the Gary Pemberton Defence Committee and other organisations in the campaign so as to make it as broad based as possible.
