

MUMTAZ KIANI and her two young British born daughters, Nadia and Attia are threatened with DEPORTATION under the 1971 Immigration Act.

Mumtaz Kiani came to Britain in 1975 as a visitor. In April 1977 she married Mohammad Younis Kiani. In May 1978 Mrs. Kiani was given INDEFINITE LEAVE TO REMAIN in the U.K.

In 1980 the Home Office investigated Mr. Kiani's status and alleged that he was a seaman deserter. He was deported in February 1981.

Mumtaz Kiani CHOSE to stay. The Home Office are now saying that she has been here without leave since 1977 and are trying to deport her.

Mumtaz Kiani's husband has written to her saying that he has no accomodation and does not want her back.

Mumtaz has no relatives in Pakistan. Her mother and father are not alive. The only close relative that she has is her brother with whom she resides in Bradford.

MUMTAZ, NADIA, and ATTIA have NOWHERE to go!

MUMTAZ KIANI has lived here since 1975.

NADIA and ATTIA WERE BORN HERE.

THE HOME OFFICE GAVE HER INDEFINITE LEAVE TO REMAIN HERE!

THEY HAVE A RIGHT TO BE HERE!

The Home Office is breaking its own word. They gave her the right with one hand and are trying to take it away with the other hand. They are DISHONEST!

This DEPORTATION IS MOTIVATED BY HOME OFFICE RACISM. It is Racist, Inhuman, Unjust.



Black people in Britain are facing ever increasing racist attacks. Black people face racism at work, they face greater rates of unemployment. There is Racism in the schools and hospitals. We face attacks in the streets and on our homes by racists and facists and we face the RACISM OF THE STATE, which loses no opportunity no matter how inhuman in trying to get rid of Black people. The ONLY WAY we can SURVIVE is by DEFENDING OURSELVES and UNITY.
