In the past year we have seen several somewhat unexpected happenings ranging from National Media attention to the expulsion of our Chairperson.disappointed and regretfully but with enthusiasm and hope I write this report.

Over the last 12 months or so we have achieved and done very little comparative to our potential and capabilities. The underlying factors being :

We must now seriously, honestly and critically examine ourselves so that once again we can begin to do the "business"

We can not afford to leave this task any longer, I believe a now or never situation is now inevietable. Comrades we need to act now. Please remember as individuals we are here to work collectively and contribute to the Organisation of which not enough has materialised over the last year. At this stage I would urge you to ask youself, honestly, "Do you seriously want to be part of our Organisation and willing to play the part necessary. If not I sincerely suggest you ought to leave our Organisation or perharps consider Associate membership.
