No more divided families DEFEND POW YEAN LEONG

Pow Shien Leong of Leeds has just won her fight to keep her son, Chun Hee with her in this country. On April 3rd, she heard that the Home Office had agreed to let him stay.

Now Pow Shien has another fight on her hands. She has just heard that the Home Office have refused permission to stay to her sister, Pow Yean Leong.

Pow Yean came to England in 1979 to look after her ailing parents in Leeds. She has lived with them since then and they still need her to look after them. She even has a note from her parents' doctor saying that they need full-time care. Pow Shien, her parents and most of the family have made their lives here. Pow Yean's life is here too!

There is nowhere for Pow Yean to go to in Malaysia. She has no home there now. But the Home Office seem determined to harass and split up this family. Pow Yean was adopted as a baby in Malaysia, she has never known her natural parents. In fact she didn't even know she was adopted until the Home Office informed her! The Home Office say that they are "not satisfied that she is the legally adopted daughter" of her parents here.

In case one reason is not enough, the Home Office also said that Pow Yean does not satisfy the requirements for permanent residence in this country.

Pow Yean is appealing the decision not to let her stay. This gives her more time. In the meantime we need to build massive support for her right to stay here.

Others have fought the Home Office by taking a stand and asking for support. They have exposed the racism and the inhumanity of the immigration laws and won! Anwar Ditta had to fight for six years to bring her children here. Jaswinder Kaur, Nasira Begum, Nasreen Akhtar, Cynthia Gordon and Shirley Graham all fought mass campaigns and won their right to stay.

Others are still fighting. Najat Chafee is fighting for her right to stay and that of her three year old son. In Bradford a whole family of people are campaigning to win support for their right to stay. In Sheffield the Home Office is threatening to deport a three year old child.

We are asking for your support for Pow Yean Leong as one individual fighting the immigration laws and for your support in building a strong united movement to bring all the individuals together. We demand that the Home Office let Pow Yean Leong stay!
