## DEFENCE COMMITTEE.

- The role of a Defence Committee is to organise support for the Defendants by: raising money;organising events;publicising material arguing the case of the Campaign;putting pressure on the police;coordinating activities where more than one support body exists, and often deciding the political line.
- 2. Two types of D.C's:
  - a] Closed- A closed D.C.is composed of people invited to participate on it with the defendants. In these cases the D.C. usually decides the political line itself because there are no "outsiders". Broad -based support can sometimes be a problem.
  - b] Open- An open D.C. is one where organisations are asked to affiliate & send a delegate. In such cases the "political line"is usually decided by defendants and close advisers.

Whatever the case, the D.C. must be composed of defendants & political activists - otherwise decision making becomes difficult and time consuming.

I would like to make the following proposals:

- Defendants decide a general political line.
- 2. Invite a few people to organise an open D.C.
- 3. The defendants each nominate one representative for themselves onto the committee.
- Some defendants must attend D.C. meetings.
- 5. The D.C. organises Support Groups in Oldham, Manchester, London and other areas if possible.
- People from these areas have access and are invited to participate on the D.C.
