Arrangements for their return to India will accordingly be set in hand."

These are the concluding words of a letter from Timothy Raison, Minister of State at the Home Office, to Ben Ford MP for Bradford North.

JARNAIL SINGH aged 55 and his wife
has worked at Crofts foundry
for the last two years.

GURMEJ KAUR aged 58
Has worked in the textile industry
for many years.

Parents of -

BAHADUR SINGH aged 24
has worked at RMI for the past
four years and is an active
member of his trade union.

MOHINDER SINGH aged 26
Has worked at RMI for the past
five years and is a member of the
National Society of Metal Mechanic

And their wives -

KALASH KAUR aged 23
is mother of two children -

JAGDISH KAUR aged 25
Has worked as a machinist for
five years.

GURDEP KAUR aged 2
and suffers from 'focal fits',
she is on a two year course of
specialist medicine.

They are all jointly accused of deception on the authorities. The Home Office has
communicated with any of these individuals to inform them of what is being prepared
against them. Neither have they been told of any rights they may have.

This is a brutal example of the workings of the laws on immigration and nationality
people working in local factories; studying in local schools, respected members of o
community, are threatened with being uprooted and deprived of everything they have
worked for.

Their infant children are ruthlessly penalised. Two of those threatened - Bahadur
and Mohinder - were aged 13 and 16 on entry to the U.K. yet they are accused of prac
deception on the authorities. It must also be remembered that the amnesty of 1972 al
